BAGRII-SHAKHMATOV Leonid Vasyliovych (December 27, 1927, Odessa – September 12, 2009, Odessa) – jurist, founder of the scientific school in the specialty 12.00.08, studied the problems of criminal and criminal-executive law, criminology. Doctor of Law; Professor; Honored Worker of Science and Technology of Ukraine; Head of the Department of Criminal Law and Criminology Faculty of Law, Odessa State University. I. I. Mechnikov; since 1997 – Head of the Department of Criminal Law of Odessa National Law

Academy; since 2000 – Vice-Rector of Odessa National Maritime University for teaching and methodological work in the field of law; Head of the Department of Criminal and Administrative Law of Odessa National Maritime University; Academician and Head of the Department of Legal Sciences of the Ukrainian Academy of Sciences. He had many other honorary and scientific titles in international organizations. Leonid BAGRII-SHAKHMATOV is one of the 200 most famous and honorable people on the planet, based on a book published in London in 2000.

He developed a number of completely innovative ideas, which he researched in the development of his own scientific school. The main ones are: 1. Substantiated development of abolitionisme during the reign of the classical approach in the theory of criminal executive law. 2. Foundation of the theory of classification of punishments and other criminal law measures, which is a prerequisite for modern theories of a multi-track system of criminal influence (theory of other criminal law measures).

He has trained more than 10 doctors of law and 70 candidates of law (Doctor of Philosophy) in different years. Followers of his scientific ideas work in various branches of the legal system of Ukraine and other countries, in various universities, including Odessa National Maritime University. These are a number of well-known scientists and members of the teaching staff of Odessa National Maritime University: H. Y. Puzanova, O. O. Kukshynova, V. M. Kuzmenko, V. M. Prystup, I. O. Danylova, O. M. Ivanova, O. M. Borshchevska, A. Yu. Kuliiev and others.
